On the day pupils will be given a time slot to do their run and can either jog or run to music whilst they follow the flags around the course.

Pupils will have the opportunity to choose which run they would like to do. The options are:

1.5K, 3K and 5K (all pupils have already achieved a 1.5K in PE lessons)

We are also delighted to announce that we have Rhonda Moore attending the event and we would love all the pupils to show their support for the **WEAR YELLOW** campaign and wear a symbol of **YELLOW** on the day to represent Yolanda's favourite flower – a sunflower.

This can be things like shoe laces, a wrist band, ribbon, t-shirt, costume etc.

What to remember for the day:

- It's important to wear the correct footwear
- Have plenty of water to drink
- Wear comfortable clothing. They can also wear something FUN!! (colourful / costume – that they can run in)
- Don't forget your symbol of yellow.
- Pupils will also be able to listen to music, which we will be playing on the field.
- The sponsorship form and sponsorship money. **Sponsorship forms and money should be brought in a sealed envelope to school with your child's name and class on the day of the run.**

What to prepare before the day:

- Prepare what they will wear - wear something yellow, something fun to dress up in or something colourful - but mainly something sporty which they can run in.
- Before the event they could do some training to prepare themselves physically e.g. interval training. An average running time for the 5k is approximately 25 minutes (please don't worry if your child can't achieve a time like this – it all about taking part, but for the more competitive runners they may like to challenge to beat this time.)
- Prepare the sponsorship form and money raised.
